**FLORIDA POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY STATE SCIENCE FAIR
 PROVOST SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

Up to five (5) 11th or 12th grade Finalists of the 69th State Science and Engineering Fair of Florida will be awarded the Florida Polytechnic University Provost Scholarship. The scholarship has a total value of \$19,760 over four years (\$2,470 per semester for up to 8 semesters). If a student has been admitted and received a Florida Polytechnic University Provost Scholarship upon admission, the student will not receive additional merit scholarship. If a student has already received a Provost scholarship for a lower amount, the State Science Provost Scholarship will replace the original award. If a student has already received a Provost Scholarship award in the same amount, the scholarship will be re-named as the State Science Provost Scholarship. Students awarded any Florida Poly Scholarship must meet all scholarship requirements for disbursement and renewal.
